Share it with your family or bring it to school.</p>	<p><u>Recount</u></p> <p>Write a recount as if you were caught up in a natural disaster—volcano, earthquake.</p>
<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Create a volcano— you could draw or paint it, use collage materials or create a model using junk modelling items.</p>		<p><u>World Map</u></p> <p>Mark on a world map where volcanoes and earthquakes occur, including the Pacific Ring of Fire.</p> 
<p><u>Pompeii</u></p> <p>Research the events of the volcanic eruption in Pompeii. Where is Pompeii? When did it happen? What happened?</p>	<p><u>Humans and Animals– Being Healthy</u></p> <p>Investigate different food groups and how they keep us healthy.</p> <p>Design a healthy meal based on what you find out.</p>	<p><u>Skeletons and Muscles</u></p> <p>Investigate humans and some animals that have skeletons and muscles.</p> <p>Identify and group animals with and without skeletons.</p>
