Children have safeguarding training to help them keep themselves safe. Annually they have:

- E-safety to keep them safe while using the internet.
- **PANTS** a NSPCC programme to prevent abuse. www.nspcc.org.uk/preventing-abuse/keeping-children-safe/underwear-rule
- Anti-bullying week.

Over a two year cycle:

- NSPCC
- **police** (road safety)
- fire brigade
- first aid Heart start course.
- bikeability

All children who have a food allergy have their pictures on the staff room notice board and in the kitchen. Alongside these are medical health plans of children and staff who need them to be followed to make them safe.
