
Microsoft Teams

We will use Microsoft Teams to contact children each day. We will have virtual meetings, set work and feedback on work using this platform.

To login your child uses their school email address and password which can be found in the letter sent out to you or stuck into your child's reading journal.

Logging in:



2. Click on the 'Sign in' button.





3. Now type in your school email address and password (from the letter or the sticker stuck in their reading journal). Type the email address exactly as it is shown.


Type email address here and then your password when prompted.

5. This is what Teams looks like.




This is your Class Team where work will be shared and meetings will take place.

This is where you will find home learning activities which have been set by your class teacher.


This will show you when your scheduled meetings are (day and time).

This tells you what your Teams are and which teams you are in.


6. Work has been assigned in the Class Notebook

7. There Literacy and Maths lessons assigned by day and a folder with other lessons that have been assigned for the week.




Clicking on your name will open the folders

Lessons are shown here


8. It is possible to write on the work using the tools or to click on the page and type in a text box.




Clicking on the Draw tab will open the drawing tools

Clicking on the text box will open the text box


9. To attend meetings you will be able to see the meetings in your calendar this is what it looks like. You will see the meeting in the calendar that you can join. Click on the meeting to join.



10. When you have clicked on a meeting this window will open. Make sure your camera is on but your microphone is off when you join the meeting. Then click 'Join Now'



11. When in a meeting, moving the mouse over the back screen activates a toolbar which looks like this.




Video on/off

Microphone on/off



12. All students have access to Microsoft Office programmes. If using the Teams App programmes can be accessed by clicking on Files.



Clicking on New will drop down the list of programmes.

13. If using the Web version of Teams, Microsoft Office the programmes can be accessed by clicking on the 9 dots in the left hand corner.



14. All Microsoft Office Programmes can be accessed by a Google search for O365. You can login using your school email address and password and use these apps.
