Year 4 Homework—Voyage of Discovery—Spring Term 2021

Homework in Year 4 will consist of spellings, as well as reading at home and learning multiplication tables, both of which are ongoing activities. The Voyage of Discovery grid below contains extra activities, which can be completed anytime throughout the Spring Term. They can be brought in whenever an activity is completed.

Pyramids

Make a pyramid from Ancient Egypt—you could use junk modelling materials, wooden bricks or lego!

Library

Borrow a book on Ancient Egypt, transportation, teeth or the digestive system from the library. Share it with your family or bring it to school.

Ancient Egypt

Research Ancient Egypt and create your own fact sheet. You could present it as a booklet and include pictures, diagrams and facts about the River Nile, the pyramids and Egyptian homes.

Egyptian Menu

Find out what types of food were eaten during Ancient Egypt times, such as bread, eggs and vegetables.

Then create your own menu for an Egyptian dinner.



Hieroglyphics

Research the Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet and write it out. Then create your own and use it to write your name. You could make your own scroll and write on it.

Transportation

Research types of transport, such as buses, cars, lorries or bicycles. Write down an advantage (something good) and a disadvantage (something not good) about them, such as easy to use or causes pollution.

Food Chains

Investigate food chains: draw a diagram of a food chain and label it, identifying the producer, the predator and the prey.

Teeth

Create a guide to looking after your teeth. Research different types of teeth in humans and what they do, what damages them and how to take care of them. Add pictures and diagrams.
